The IndusInd Foundation's efforts in the field of education do not stop at grant of scholarship for study at degree level. till date 3000 deserving student took the benefit from the foundation


(II)Rehabilitation of widows, destitute women, orphans, aged and the poor





## SINDHI FESTIVALS CELEBRATING WITH VIBRANT CULTURE AND THE EVOLUTION OF OUR LANGUAGE



### **Sindhi Culture/ Ekta Diwas**



Sindhi Cultural Day, known as 'Ekta Jo Diharo', is celebrated each year on the first Sunday of December. This special day is filled with traditional enthusiasm, shining a light on the rich, centuries-old culture of Sindh. It inspires us to honor and preserve the heritage of Sindh, which has thrived for thousands of years. Sindhi Cultural Day is a cherished festival that celebrates the vibrant spirit of the Sindhi community.

### Promoting / registration of the Sindhi language in India.

Sindhi Language Day is celebrated every year on April 10th, marking the 1967 inclusion of the Sindhi language in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution. Sindhi communities worldwide come together on this day to promote their rich language and culture through various inspiring events.

### " Nandi Thadri "


Nandi Thadri, a Sindhi festival in the month of Sawan, involves sharing cold food and sacred rituals.

Devotees sprinkle water on the cooking fire as a sign of devotion.

This festival is a time for special rituals and heartfelt prayers, seeking Mata Shitala's blessings for the health and well-being of the family.



### " Vadi Thadri "



Thadri is celebrated seven days after Rakshabandhan or one day before Janmashtami, honoring Sheetla Devi for good health and well-being. Families prepare and share delicious meals, including Tariyal Bhindiyu (deep-fried ladyfingers), Tariyal Karela (deep-fried bitter gourds), Saag (spinach with onion and tomato), and Sanna Pakora (chickpea flour fritters), celebrating togetherness and tradition.

### **CHETI-CHAND(SINDHI NEW YEAR) WITH BEHRANA SAHIB**



Cheti Chand is celebrated on the second day of the Sindhi month of Chet, marking the Sindhi New Year and a time for joyful remembrance.

This festival honors the birthday of Ishtadeva Uderolal, or "Jhulelal," believed to have been born in 1007 AD after prayers to the Hindu God Varun Devon for protection from the Muslim king Mirkshah. Jhulelal, son of Ratanrai Thakkar and Mata Devaki, represents hope and faith.

On the first day of Chaitra, or Cheti, celebrations feature the Bahrana Saheb, a decorated bronze thaal with Jhulelal's idol, along with a Kunri filled with water and covered in red cloth. The occasion includes lively processions, dancing, and communal feasting, uniting the community in spirit.

# THE CHALIHA SAHIB FESTIVAL (SAFEGUARDED THEM FROM CONVERSION TO ISLAM) A CELEBRATION OF LORD JHULELAL

The Chaliha Sahib festival is a 40-day celebration among Sindhi Hindus honoring Lord Jhulelal, who safeguarded them from conversion to Islam. This vibrant festival occurs in July and August, symbolizing faith and resilience.

Behrana Sahib: Sacred Offerings, During this time, the community prepares the Behrana Sahib, which includes an oil diya (lamp), cardamom, sugar, fruits, and Akho, a sweet rice dish.

The Ritual of Behrana Sahib: Taking the Behrana Sahib to a river or lake, Lighting Jyot Jagan, a diya made from wheat flour, Immersing the Behrana Sahib in water & Singing Pallav for blessings.



This offering, comprised of flowers, fruits, and sweets, is immersed in water as a tribute to the water deity, seeking blessings of prosperity, health, and happiness.
